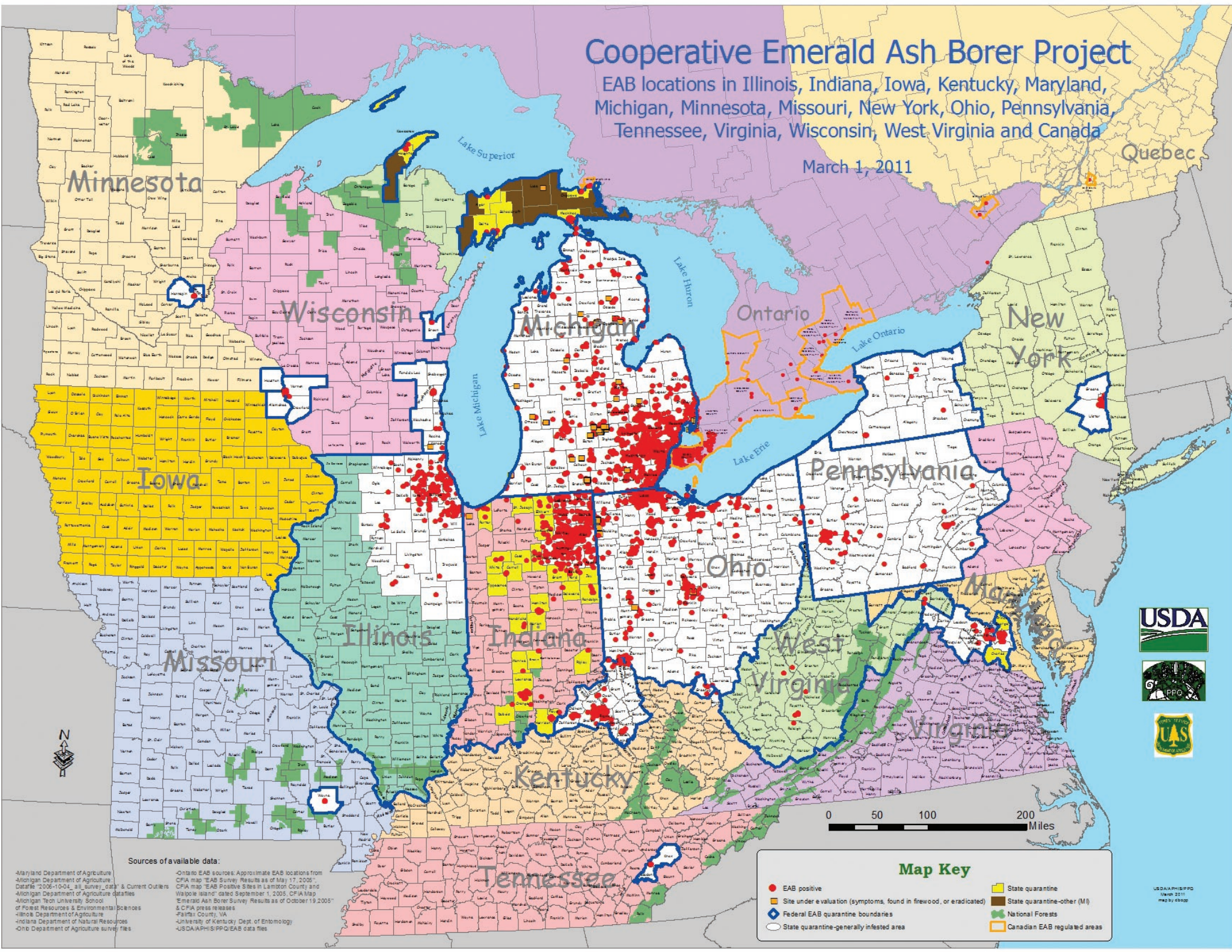


# Cooperative Emerald Ash Borer Project
